Services include treating children with amplified pain through intensive physical, occupational, and psychological/creative arts therapy to restore function without pain medications. This is a daily program, 8 AM to 4 PM that may take from 1 to 7 weeks (average 4 weeks) and can be either inpatient or outpatient, depending on the need.
